Packaging EPR Schemes by Country

Under extended producer responsibility (EPR), the party that places packaged goods on a national market usually has to register with, and pay into, a packaging scheme in that country. When you ship across the EU, that duty can arise in several states at once. This directory lists the main packaging scheme or register per country as a starting point for your own checks.
